

Top tips to help families discover the magic of reading

Sharing stories together helps us discover ourselves and others. Celebrate with Little Miss Tiny as she realises that everyone has something about them that makes them special.

Here are some top tips from the National Literacy Trust to help families bring stories to life at home:

- Encourage your child to celebrate being different! Help your child pick three favourite qualities about themselves. Now ask them to do the same for a friend or a family member. Taking care of yourself and thinking about others builds children's confidence and enjoyment in the way they interact with the world around them.

- Why not give audiobooks and storytelling videos a try? They can be really fun and are also great for children who aren't keen on reading.

- Make story time fun by using different voices for characters and acting out your favourite parts.

We are all wonderfully different and equally special.


What makes you ... You?

Little Miss Tiny sometimes wishes she was taller.




Did you know that she has a friend called Mr Tall?

Though that's another story!




One of the friends who helped him was Mr Tickle, who has extraordinarily long arms.

"I wish I was bigger," she replied. "I went to the park and I'm too tiny to get onto the swing."




Mr Tickle smiled widely.

Whereas Mr Messy is so messy that he's even left a trail of messy fingerprints on this page!




As you may have realised, their names say quite a lot about them.

Little Miss Tiny may be small, but she has a BIG personality!




When they arrived at the park, Mr Clever was sat reading his book in the shade.

Little Miss Tiny went straight over to join Little Miss Somersault.




Then Mr Tickle used his extraordinarily long arms to lift Little Miss Tiny onto the swing.

The world is all the more balanced and interesting because people are different.


Little Miss Chatterbox likes to talk a lot.

What name would your family give you?




Nothing is too splendid for Little Miss Splendid.

Their houses are very different, but suit them both perfectly.




Did you know that there is a place called Twoland?

They are almost as small as Little Miss Tiny.




Now the Little Miss Twins may look alike, but they are very different.

Where could she be?




Little Miss Tiny searched high and low, and soon realised that size is her superpower as she's able to get into the smallest places.

"It looks like being tiny isn't so bad after all!" she laughed.


Mr Tickle beamed happily.

"You may be tiny, but you're brave and funny too and I say that calls for ...




... double the tickles!"

With which, Little Miss Twin cheekily tickled her too!






