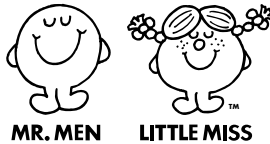

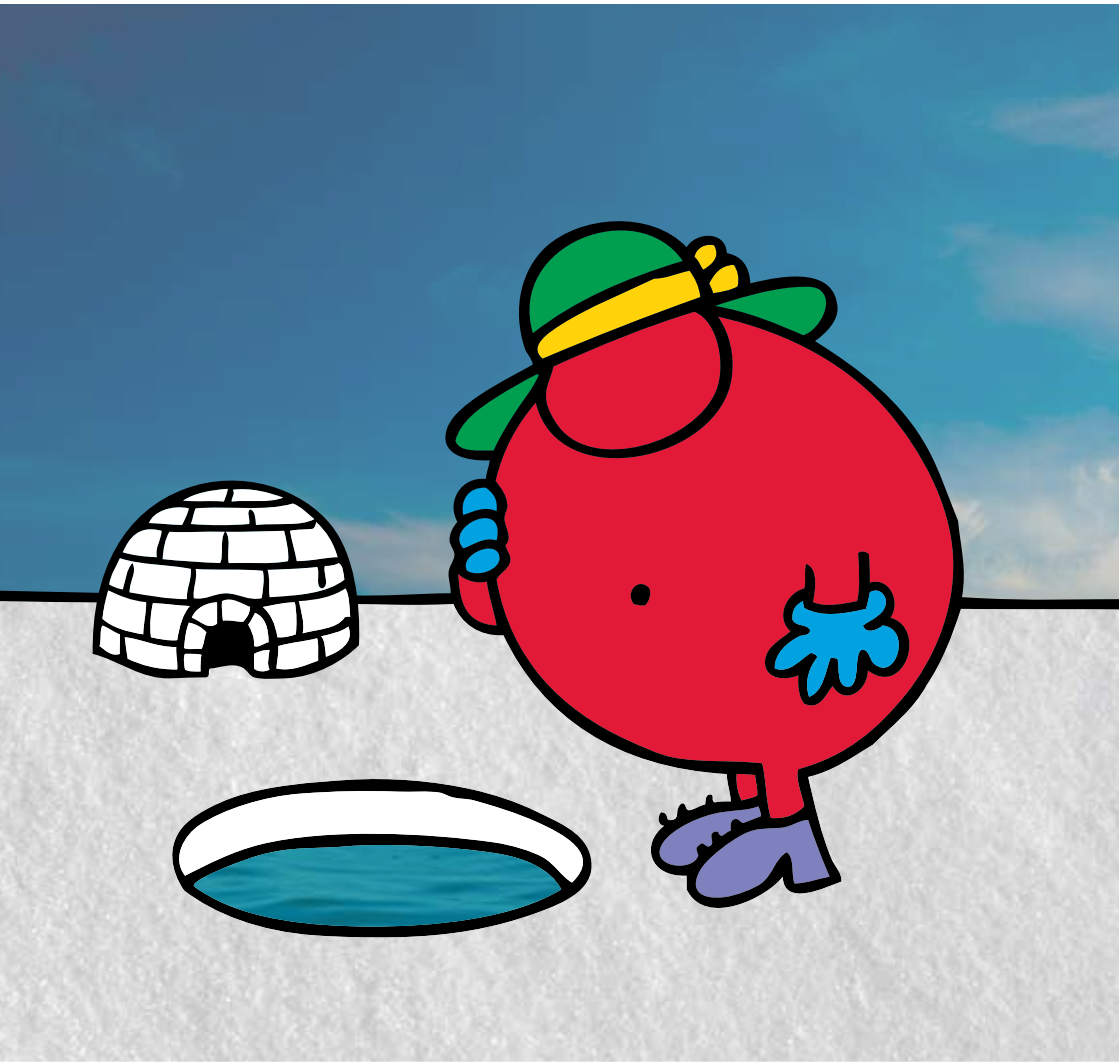
Little Miss Sunshine felt very sorry for Little Miss Scatterbrain when she heard about her holiday.

But being the scatterbrained person she is, she went to the North Pole!

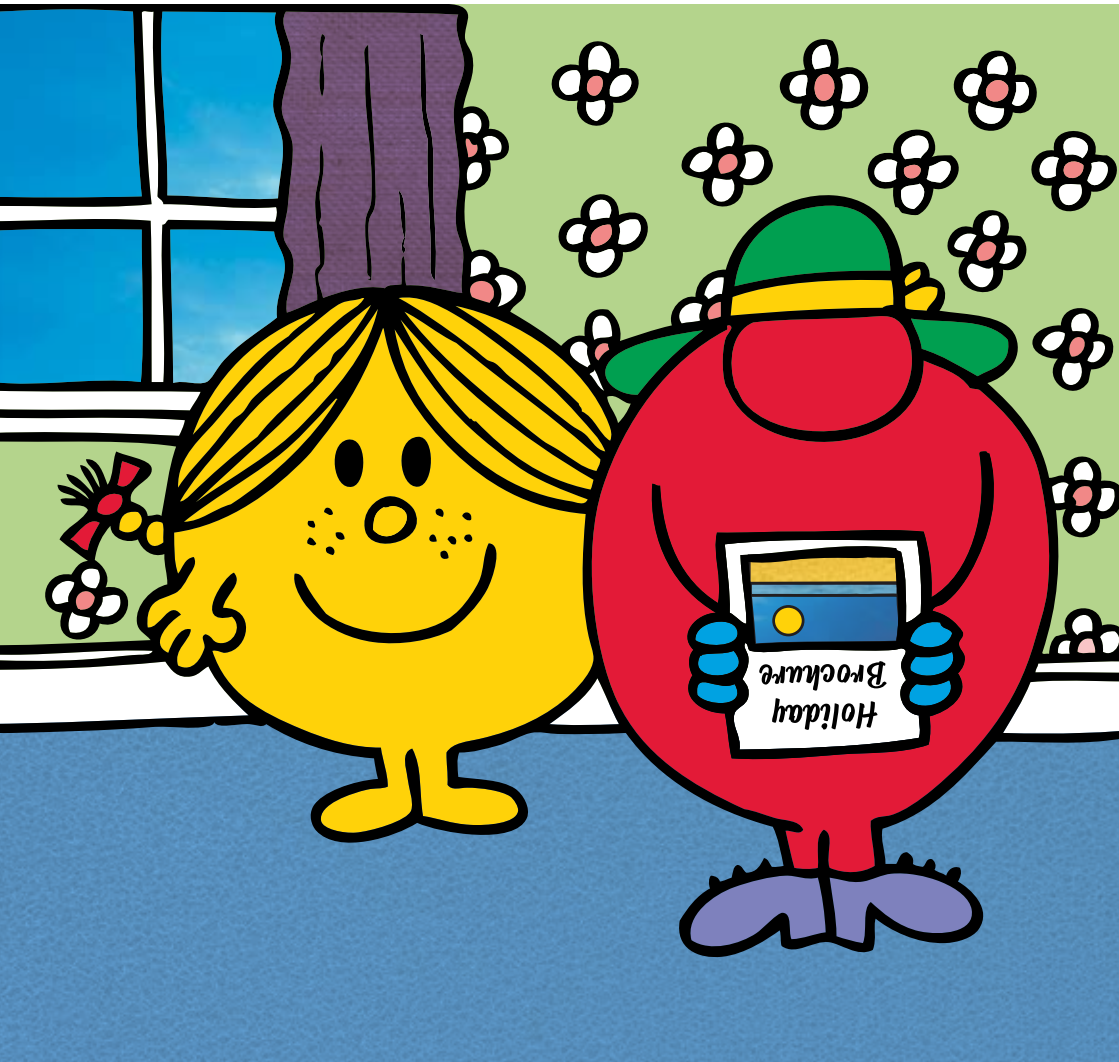
It was a bit chilly for swimming.

So this year, Little Miss Sunshine decided to organise Little Miss Scatterbrain's summer holiday for her.

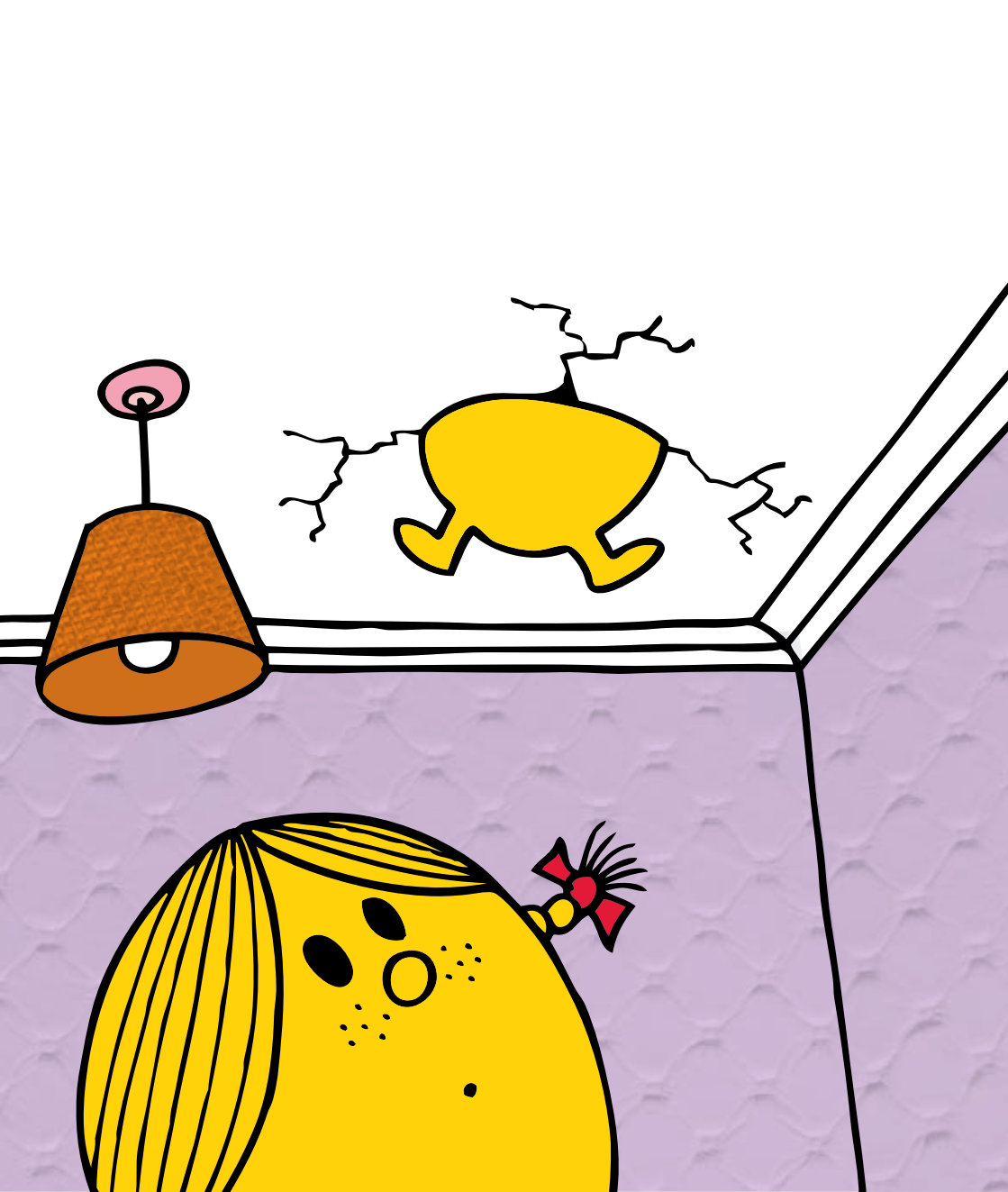
And to make it really fun, she invited along lots of Little Miss Scatterbrain's friends as well.

Little Miss Sunshine packed all her things in her suitcase.

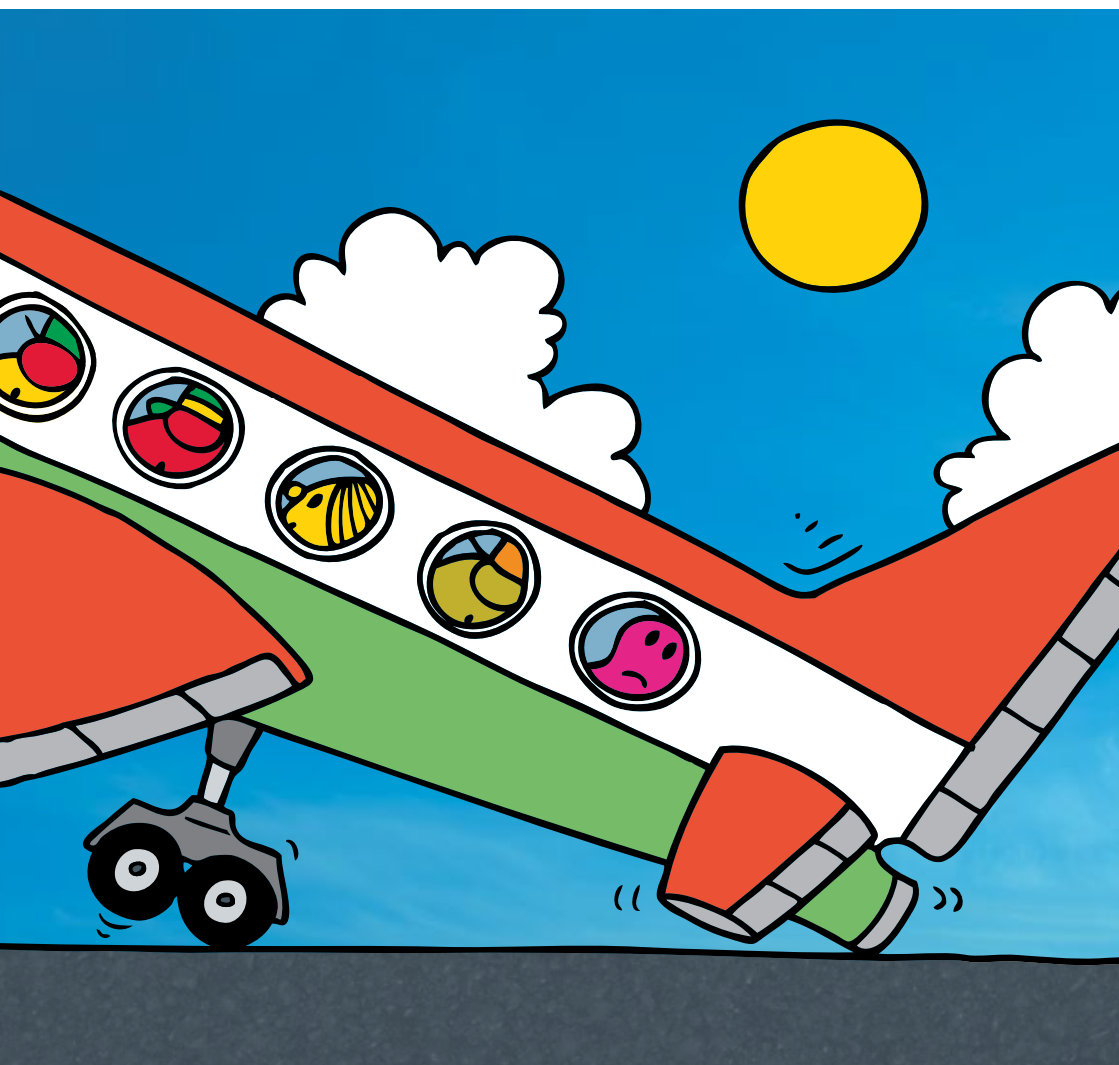
And then she went round to help Little Miss Scatterbrain, who had packed all her things in her bookcase!



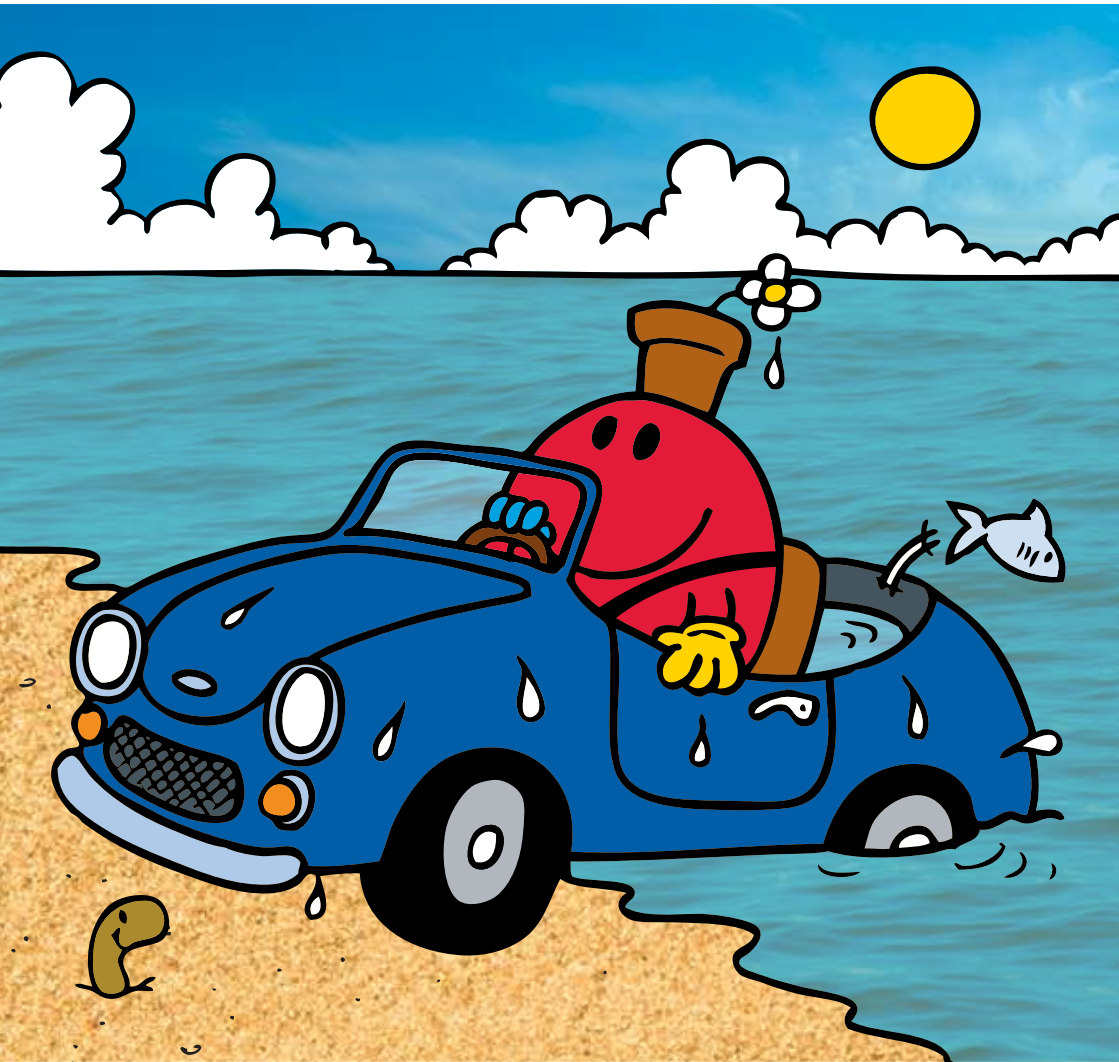
The next day, everyone got the bus to the airport and boarded the plane.

Mr Wrong decided to drive.

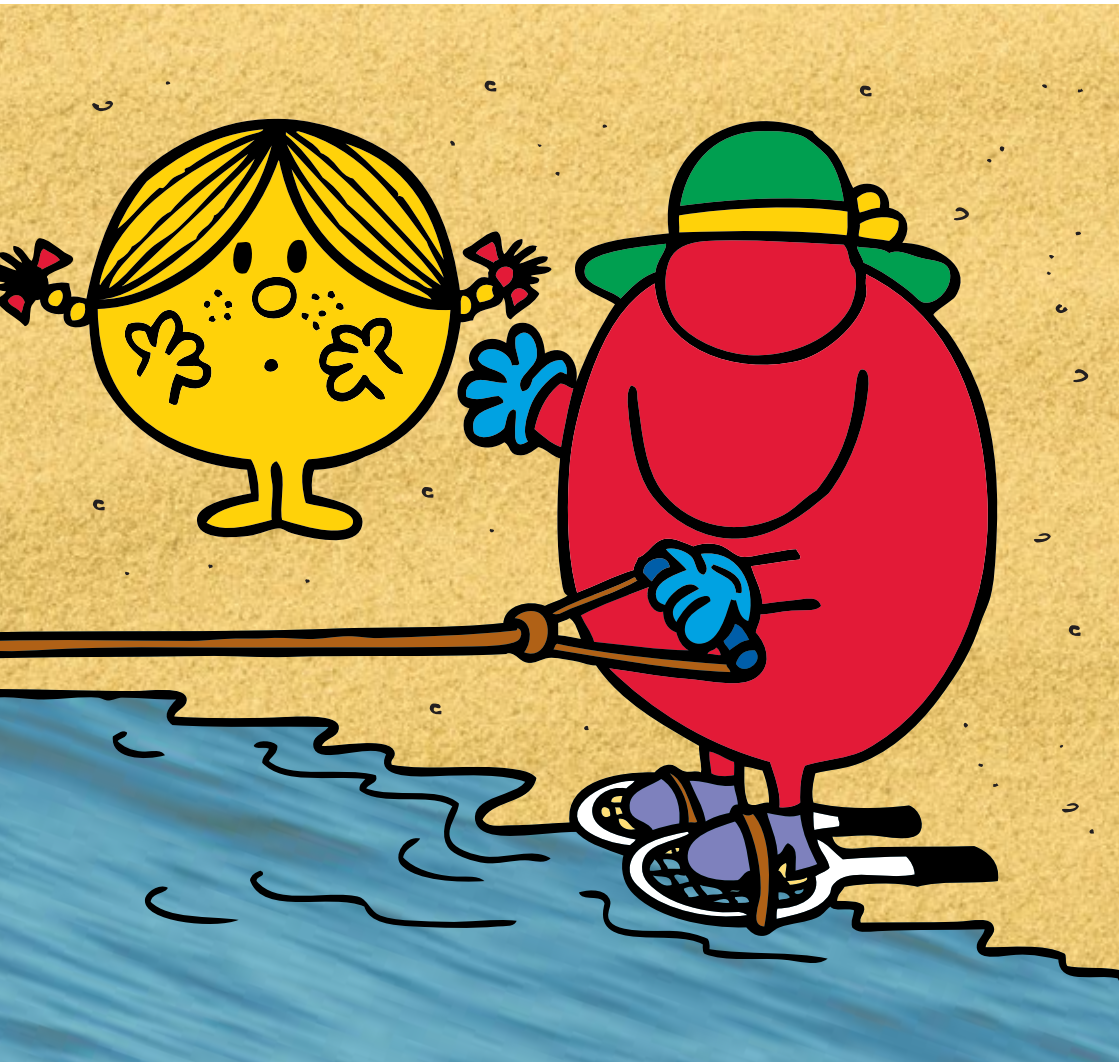


The first day of their holiday dawned bright and sunny and everybody headed to the beach.

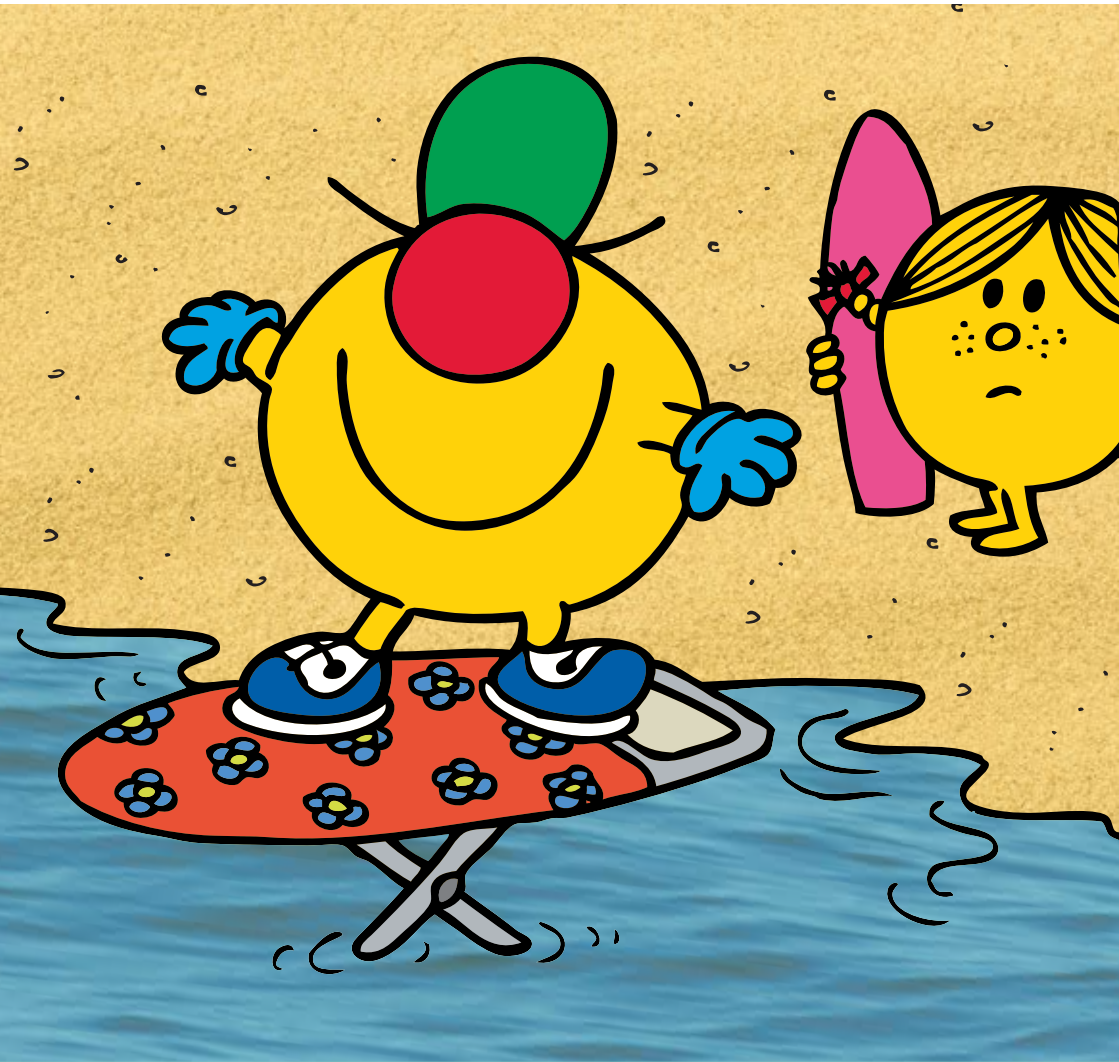
In fact, they went to the beach every day that week.

On the second day, she had to show Mr Nonsense how to surf.

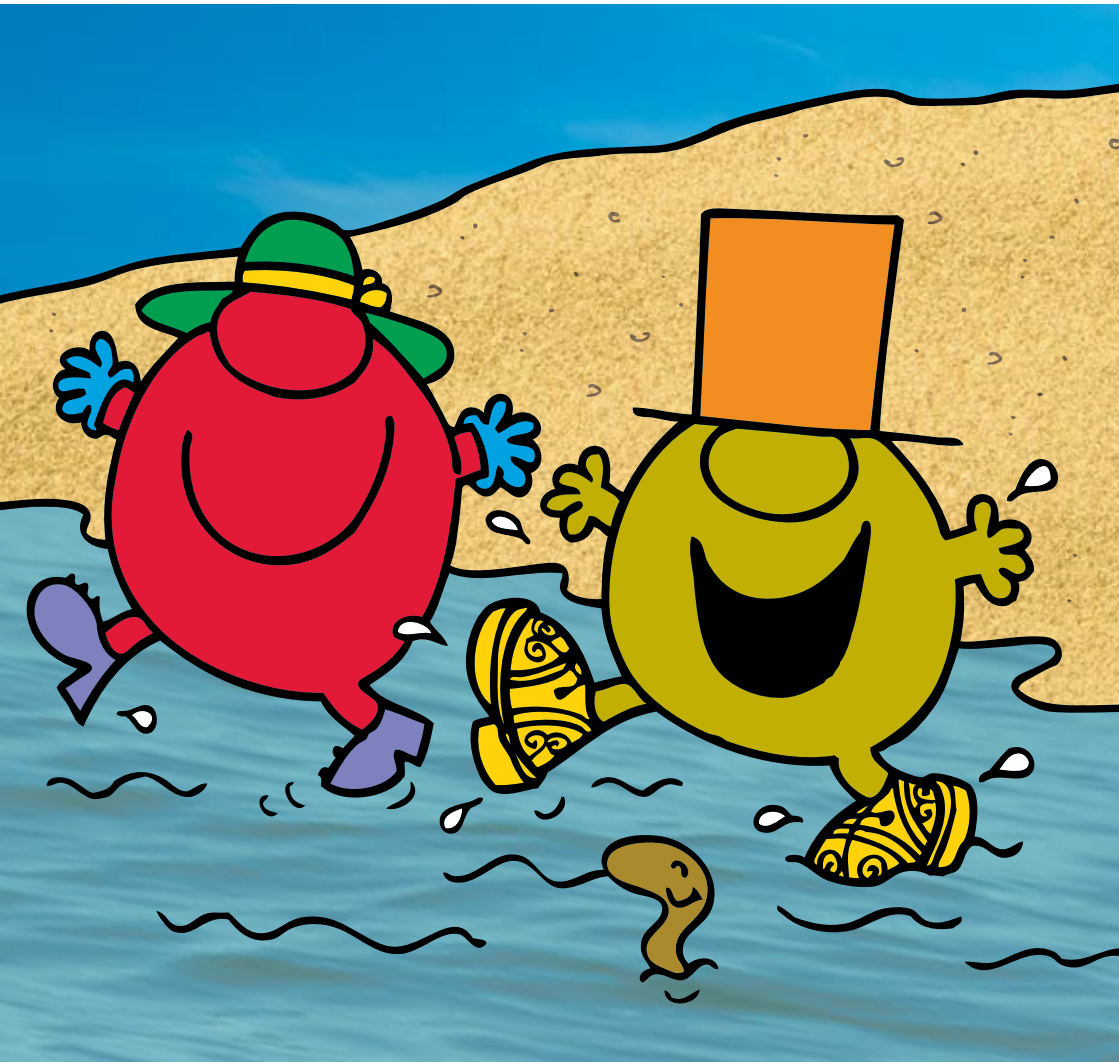


Then Mr Silly went swimming in the sea.

Little Miss Scatterbrain thought it perfectly sensible.

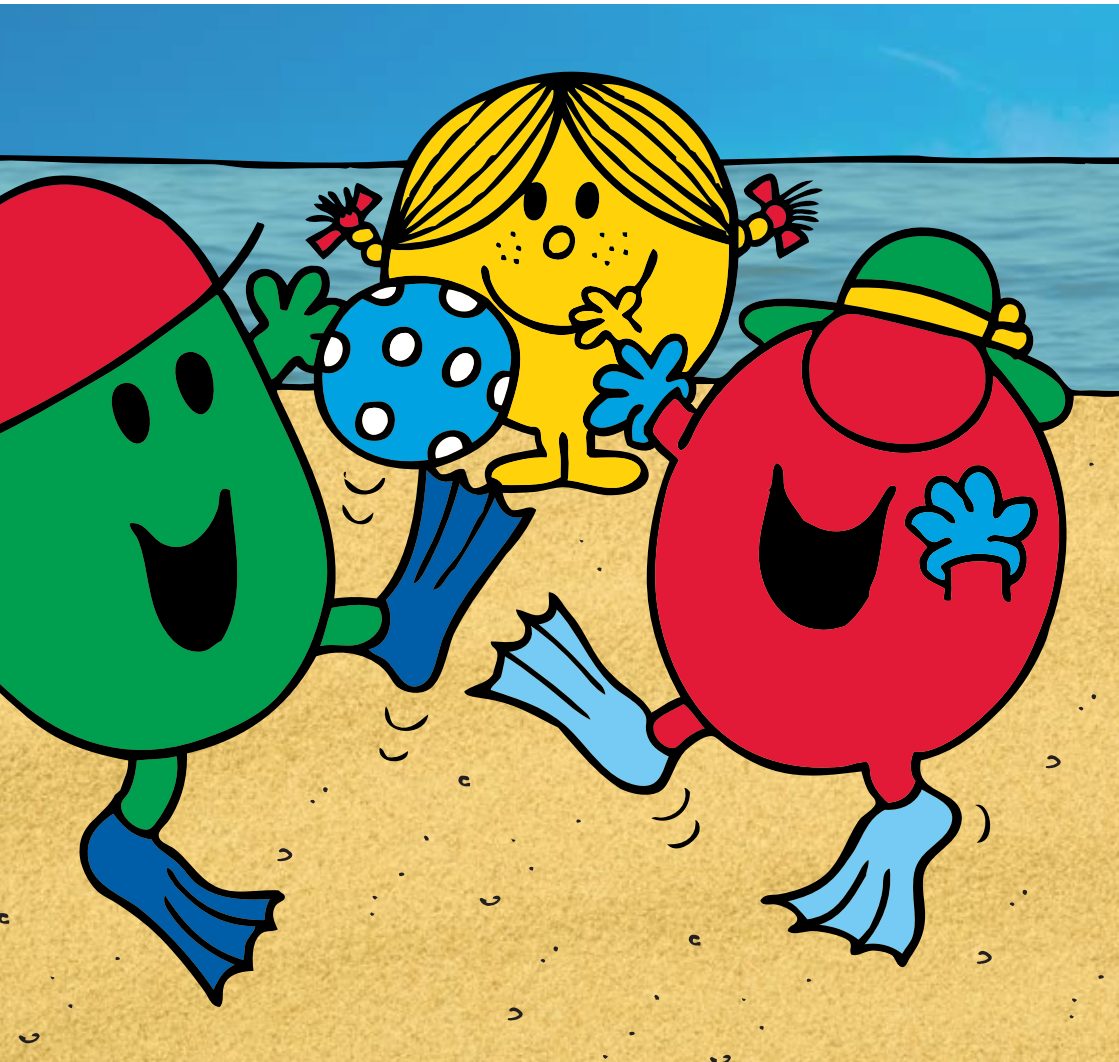


The next day, Little Miss Dotty made a sandcastle.

On the last day, they all played football on the beach.

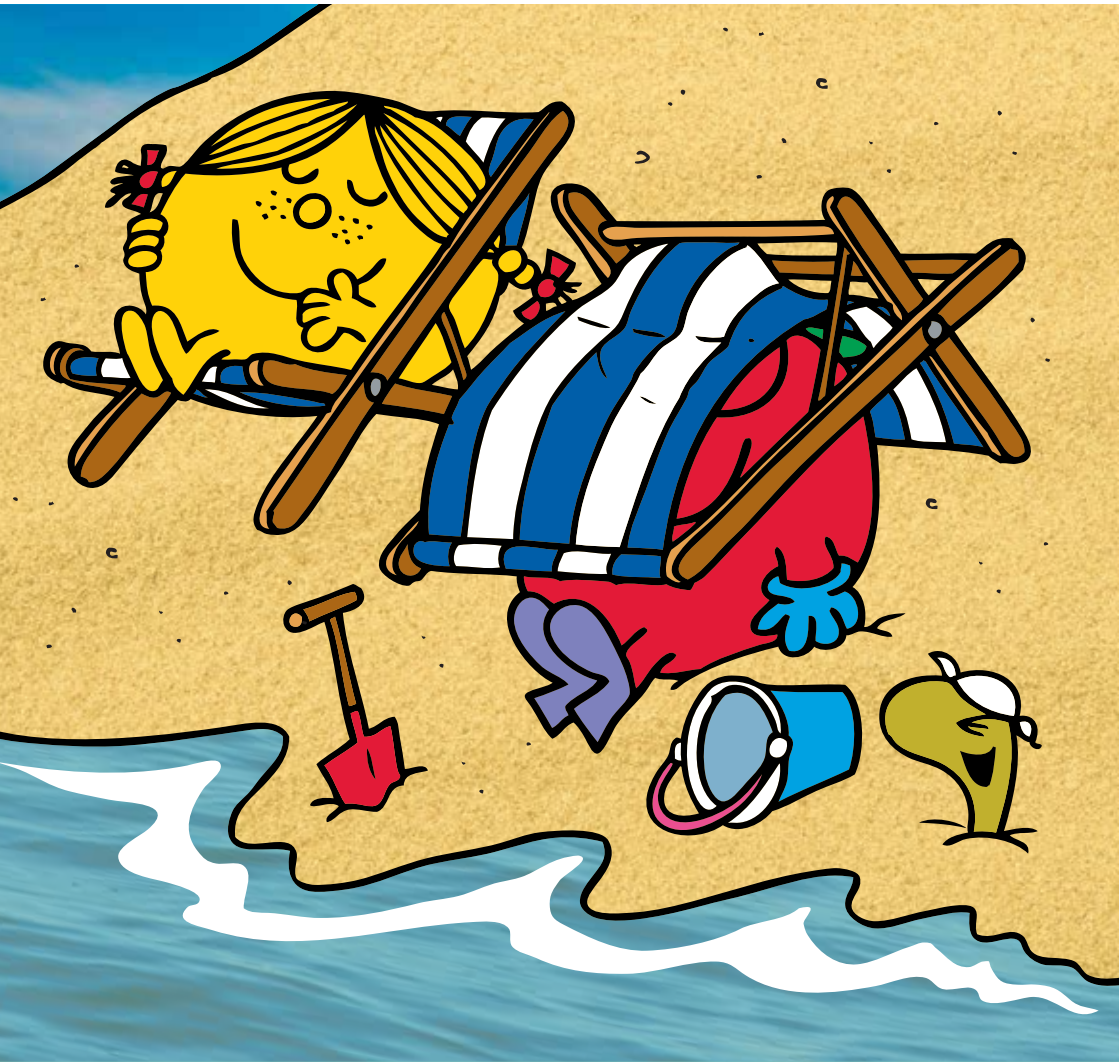
Although it was the strangest game of football that  
Little Miss Sunshine had ever seen.



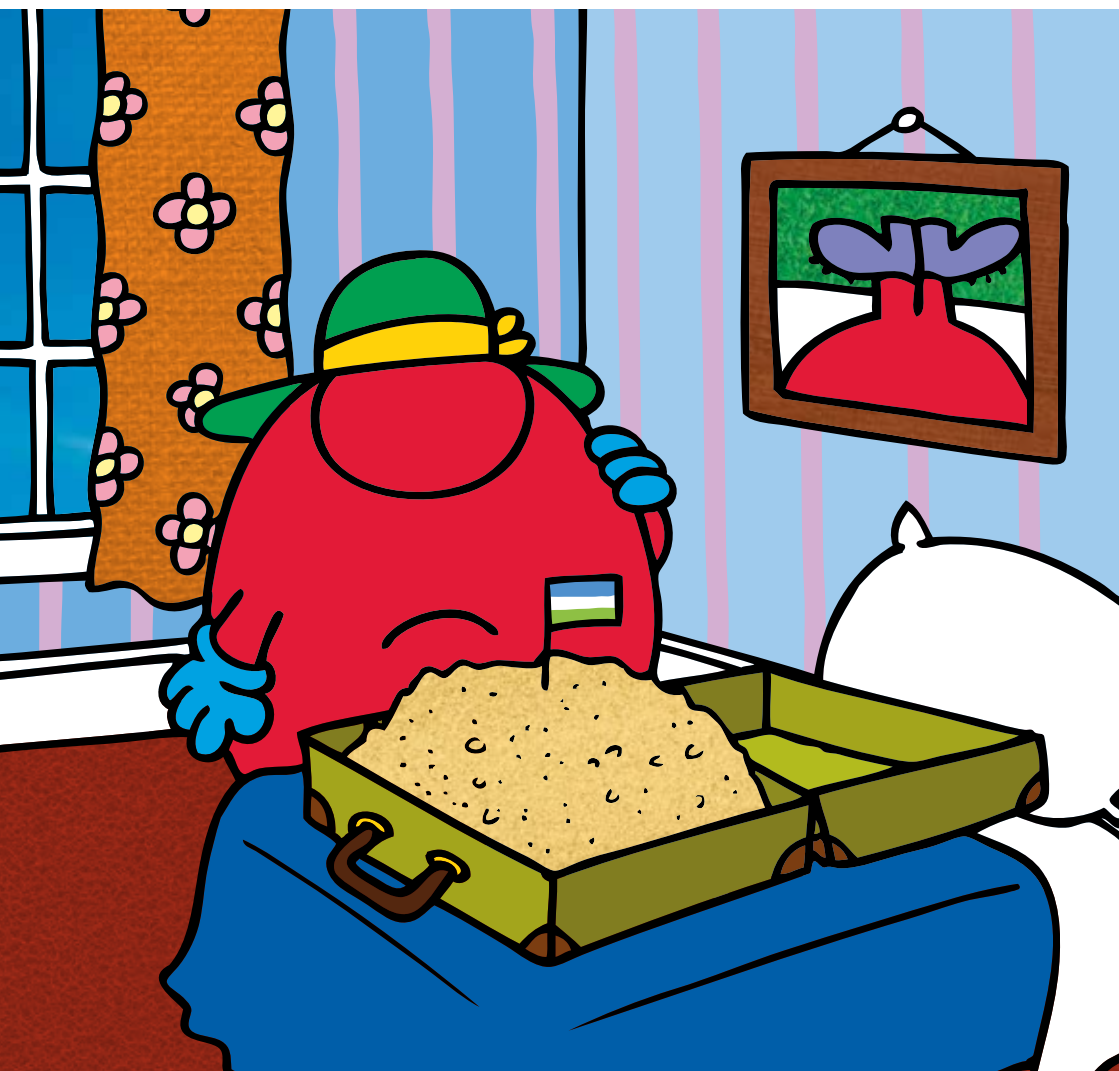
Little Miss Scatterbrain had a thoroughly wonderful week.

It was her ...



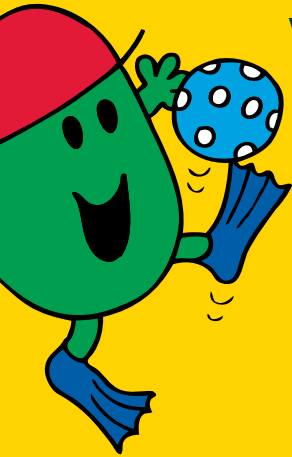
