







Sometimes Steve went on trips with his father to rescue crocodiles that were threatened by hunters. He was nine when he tried to catch his first crocodile by jumping on its back!

















Steve knew the best way to protect wild animals was by getting people to love them. His shows taught everyone how exciting wildlife is.
