

I'm sure you are sometimes, but what about the times you do what you want, without thinking of others?




It can be difficult to be kind.

Does he like being kind?


No, he does not!

He stomped on the flowers Little Miss Sunshine was growing by the path.


"Who put them there?" he raged. "They don't do anything and they can't even look after themselves!"

"No!" snapped Mr Mean. "That will teach you to drive a normal car like everyone else!"





"I agree, but it's going to be a challenge," replied Little Miss Giggles. "Perhaps we can show him how to be kinder."




So Mr Happy and Little Miss Giggles decided to help Mr Mean have a kinder day.

Even Mr Mean felt happier and brighter in their company.




Though Mr Mean still hadn't been kind to others yet.

"Excuse me, please," said Mr Small, quietly.


"No! I was here first," snapped Little Miss Stubborn, rudely.




