

Make your own 3-D apple!

Adults, help your little one create their own 3-D apple! Print out the template from the Family Fun Hub and watch our 'How To' video together to get started! **Adult supervision required.**



Materials:

- Coloured paper
- Round edged scissors
- Kids' glue
- Black pen
- Apple template from the Family Fun Hub

Instructions:

1. Print out the fruit template from the Family Fun Hub.
2. Assist your little one in cutting out the templates using round edged scissors.
3. Draw around the bigger template 3 x on red paper and assist your child in cutting this out.
4. Fold these apple shapes in half.
5. Glue one side of an apple onto a background sheet of paper.
6. Glue another on top... followed by another on top of that one.
7. Glue the last side to the background paper.
8. Then glue the white cores from the template between the folds of the apples.
9. Cut out the leaf and stem from off-cuts of paper (alternatively draw on the stem).
10. Glue on the stem and leaf.
11. Draw on seeds to finish!

Don't forget to store any unused paper for next time!
