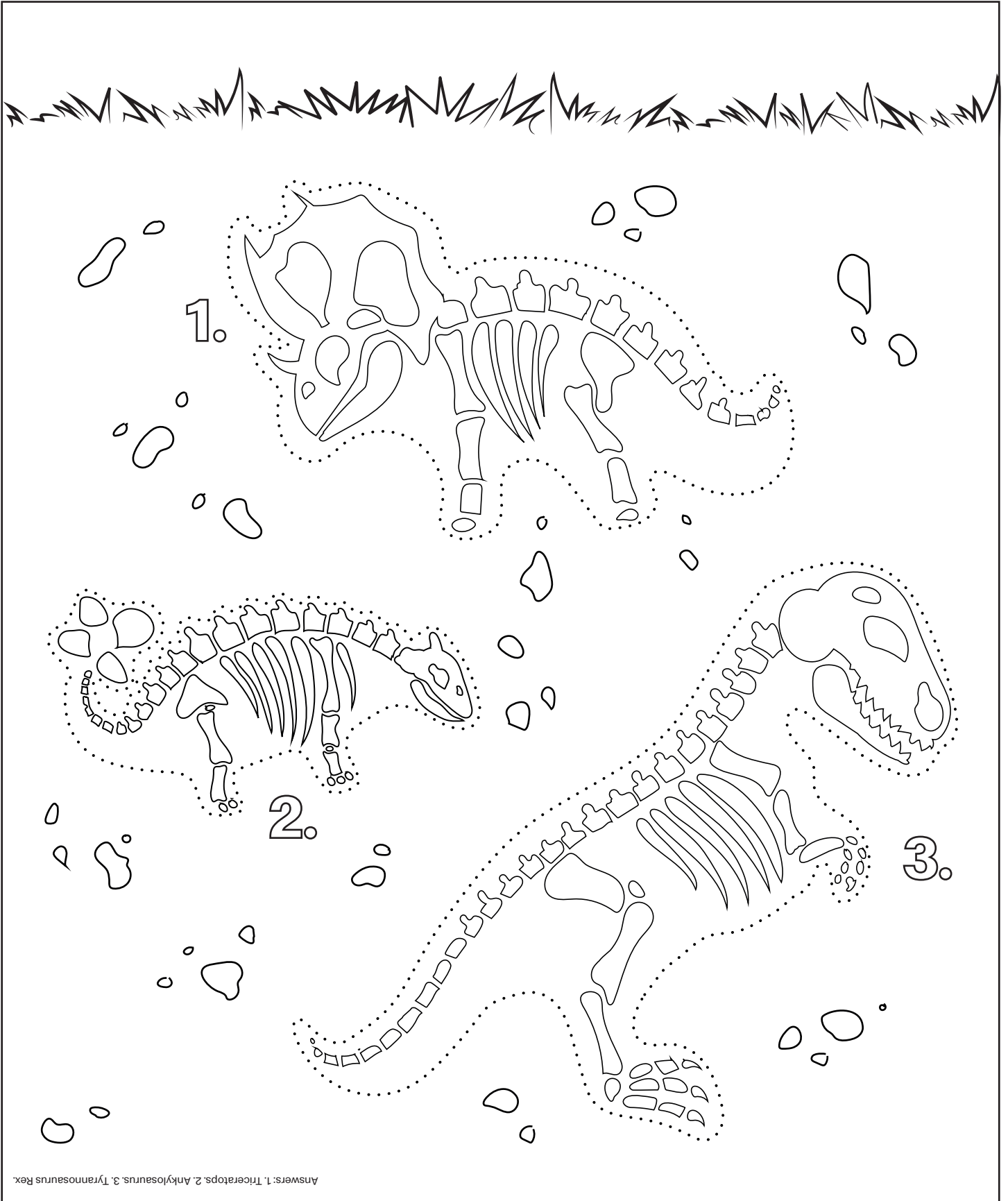

Join the dots around the fossils to discover what kind of dinosaurs they are!

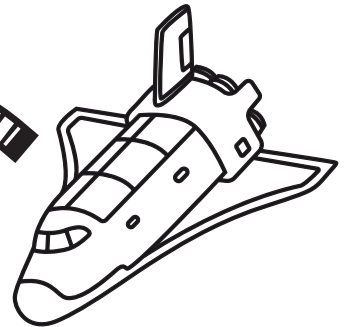
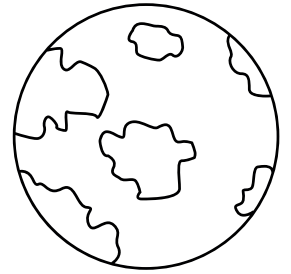
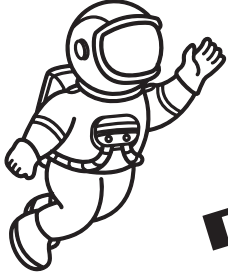


Answers: 1. Triceratops, 2. Ankylosaurus, 3. Tyrannosaurus Rex.
